RULES OF CONDUCT FOR THE ACDA ALL-STATE HONOR CHOIR SINGERS

It is expected that each singer will abide by these rules of conduct and use good judgment in personal behavior throughout the entire honor choir experience. Failure to do so will result in your immediate dismissal from the honor choir and you will be sent home.

It is your responsibility to:

- **Respond** in a positive manner to any request made of you by an Adult Chaperone or Honor Choirs coordinators.
- **Refrain** from drinking, smoking, drug usage and other illegal, improper behavior.
- **Get adequate rest** so that you are able to participate appropriately in the demanding honor choir rehearsals. **Rehearsals are not naptime!**
- **Be on time for all scheduled rehearsals. On time** to rehearsals **means** you should be in your seat at least 5 minutes prior to the start of the rehearsal not ambling in through the door when the rehearsal is scheduled to begin! **Think ahead.**
- **Refrain from idle chatter during all rehearsals.** Save your breath and brain for listening and singing.
- **Mark your music** as your director provides information during the rehearsal.
- **Enjoy** the honor choir experience

The degree of enjoyment you receive from this honor choir experience will be directly related to your degree of musical preparation that precedes your arrival, your positive participation in all rehearsals, and your willingness to engage in appropriate behavior throughout your participation in the honor choir experience.
